Cookie Policy

Cookies are IT data, particularly text files, which are stored on the User's end device and are intended for the use of the Service's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the time they are stored on the end device, and a unique number. The entity placing cookies on the User's end device and accessing them is MOTOCONTROLER sp. z o.o., headquartered in Krakow, at ul. płk. Stanisława Dąbka 8/402, 30-732 Krakow, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for Kraków-Podgórze in Krakow under KRS number: 0000932185, REGON: 520440363, NIP: 6793226824.

Cookies are used for the purpose of:

- Adapting the content of the Service's websites to the User's preferences and optimizing the use of websites; in particular, these files allow recognizing the User's device and appropriately displaying the website tailored to their individual needs;
- Creating statistics that help understand how Users of the Service use websites, which enables improving their structure and content;
- Maintaining the User's session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter their login and password on each subpage of the Service.

Within the Service, two basic types of cookies are used: "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies. "Session" cookies are temporary files stored on the User's end device until they log out, leave the website, or turn off the software (web browser). "Persistent" cookies are stored on the User's end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.

The following types of cookies are used within the Service:

- "Necessary" cookies enabling the use of services available within the Service, e.g., authentication cookies used for services requiring authentication within the Service;
- Cookies used to ensure security, e.g., used to detect fraud in the authentication process within the Service;
- "Performance" cookies enabling the collection of information on how the Service's websites are used;
- "Functional" cookies enabling "remembering" the settings selected by the User and personalizing the User's interface, e.g., regarding the selected language or region the User comes from, font size, website appearance, etc.

In many cases, software for browsing websites (web browser) by default allows the storage of cookies on the User's end device. Users of the Service can change the cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed, in particular, to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to inform about their placement on the User's device each time. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies is available in the software (web browser) settings, e.g.:

- in Internet Explorer
- in Mozilla Firefox
- in Chrome
- in Safari
- in Opera

The Service operator informs that restricting the use of cookies may affect some functionalities available on the Service's websites. Cookies placed on the User's end device can also be used by partners cooperating with the operator.
